Summary

A 250 word bio for the nominee. The bio should highlight the major contributions made by the nominee that spurred the nomination.

Rationale

Nominators should identify and justify the focus area of the nomination. Toward this goal, it is recommended to list 3-5 major impacts achieved by the nominee.
