El Yunque National Rainforest

The El Yunque National Forest is the only tropical rainforest in the *National Forest System*. At nearly 29,000 acres, it is one of the smallest in size, yet one of the most biologically diverse. Come experience the breathtaking scenery, clear mountain rivers, and outdoor recreation opportunities year round.

Entry Information:


Reservations will be required for every day of the week for all areas, with the exception of the Angelito Trail.

Reservation Information:

Visitors must create an account to purchase the ticket. The cost is \$2.00 per car, up to 2 cars per reservation.
Tickets will be available 30 days in advance of the entry date. A limited number of tickets are set aside and made available 24 hours in advance of the entrance time, 8:00 AM, each day.

Reminders:

- A vehicle is required to be able to go to every stop of the Rainforest. Parking is in designated areas only. Do not park on green areas, vehicles will be ticketed. **No** Uber or taxi can go inside.

- Some areas remain closed and under renovations, scan the code below to view the map for updates.

- Water levels at rivers can be unpredictable since rain can affect the water levels and force of currents. Please ask a Ranger at the front entrance if the rivers are okay to swim in. Water shoes are recommended.

- There is no portable water nor food vendors inside the Rainforest. Bring water, snacks and a trash bag to collect the items to discard when in the hotel.

- Trails are not stroller or wheelchair accessible. We recommend wearing shoes with traction.
